Dear Public Recreational Bathing Facility Owner,

It is time to renew your public recreational bathing facility license for the 2019 season. Annual public recreational bathing facility licenses will expire on May 31, 2019. Seasonal public recreational bathing facility licenses must be applied and paid for prior to the pre-operational inspection. A copy of this application is also available for your convenience on the Ewing Township web site at: <http://ewingnj.org/Home.aspx> under the forms page.

Checks should be made payable to: Township of Ewing. Please do not send cash. Your prompt and timely submission of this application, along with the appropriate fee is appreciated. **Late fees will be applied for licenses if payment is received after May 31, 2019.** Late fees are \$1 per day to a maximum late payment charge of \$50. Please also submit copies of current Annual Checklist, Trained Pool Operator Certificate, First Aid/CPR Certificate(s), and Life Guard Certificate(s) attained by your staff and management.

Please note: It is recommended that managers and staff routinely review N.J.A.C. 8:26 "Public Recreational Bathing", the governing Code for the State of New Jersey. Chapter 26 is also available on the web at: <https://www.nj.gov/health/ceohs/documents/phss/recbathing.pdf>.

All facilities must schedule with the Ewing Township Code Enforcement an annual Electrical Inspection and receive approval from them prior to the Health Department's pre-operational inspection.

Enclosed you will also find an application for Local Information Network Communication System (LINCS), which allows our business owners to receive Health Alerts such as Retail Food Product Recalls, Event Notifications, and other pertinent announcements.
