**New Business – We will have a new roster next month.**

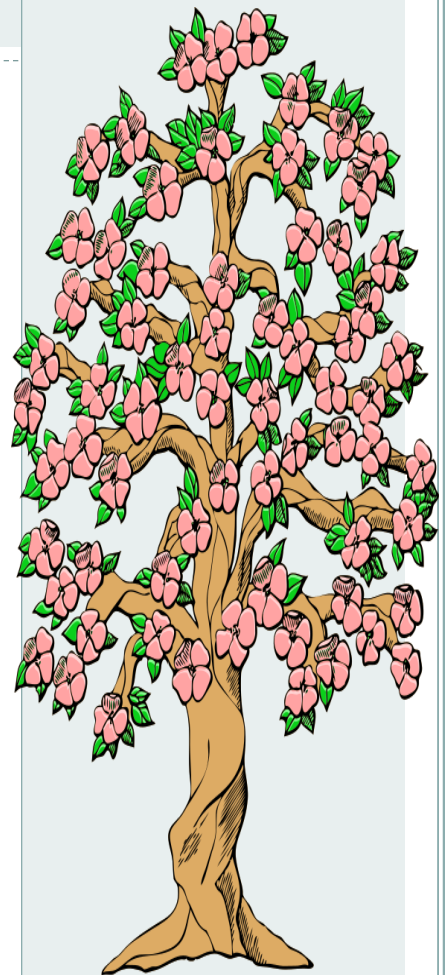

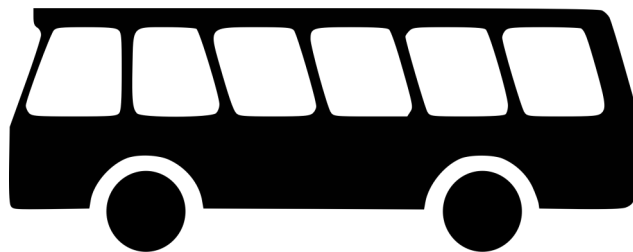
